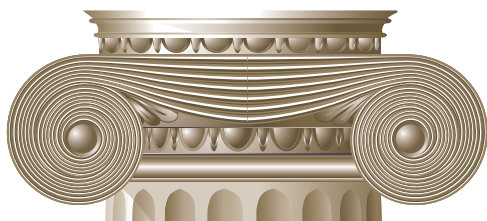

Shaved Asparagus and Cabbage Salad
with Butternut Squash Soup

Fresh asparagus is shaved paper thin and tossed with
in-season fresh white cabbage

Seasoned with toasted almonds, fresh lemon juice,

Paired with a 4 oz. demi-tasse of seasonal butternut squash soup
with prosciutto and sage

REGISTER YOUR CELL PHONE

To place bids on auction items or to make a donation, register with an AuctionsByCellular staff member in RED.
ABC staff members will be present at the event to be your "Personal Shopper" if you do not prefer to bid via your cell phone.

BID VIA SMARTPHONE

Click the BLUE link in your welcome text message and it will take you to your personal bidding page. Click on an item you would like to bid on. The ABC Smart System prepopulates with the next minimum bid so all you have to do is push BID. If you'd like to go higher just enter a new amount and push BID. To have the ABC Smart System automatically bid for you to a designated amount please select AUTO and enter a higher amount. The system will bid for you incrementally up until your designated amount only if someone bids against you.

BID VIA TEXT

To see current bid, reply to your welcome text and simply text the 3 digit item number. EXAMPLE: "102" then press send. Then, text the 3 digit item number and amount you would like to bid. No dollar sign (\$) needed. EXAMPLE: "102 300" then press send. You placed a \$300 bid on item number 102.

Simply click the donate button "\$" on your Smartphone and enter an amount or text "Give" and amount (Ex. "Give 100").

Château Margaux

Château Margaux 1982 1 bottle 750ml. Consistently scoring between 98-100, the superb 1982 Margaux may be slightly bigger, bolder and more masculine than vintages produced over the last 15-20 years. Its dark plum/purple color is followed by notes of melted tar intermixed with sweet cassis and floral underpinnings. Very full-bodied and dense, with a slight rusticity to the tannins, it boasts power, richness and impressive aromatics. It appears set for another 30-40 years of life. (RP 98)

Château Ausone

Château Ausone 1982 1 bottle 750ml. Amber at the edge is evident in this dark garnet-colored wine. Sweet notes of weedy tobacco intermixed with red currant jam, spice box and cedar jump from the glass of this relatively perfumed vintage for Ausone. The attack is sweet, with surprising glycerin and ripeness, but then the finish narrows out with plenty of tannin, hardness and structure. Anticipated maturity: 2008-2030. (RP 90)

Château Gruaud Larose

Château Gruaud Larose 1982 1 bottle 750ml. A massive wine that is clearly of first-growth quality in this vintage. A dense, thick, unctuously textured, inky/plum/garnet/purple color offers up scents of beef blood, steak tartare, cassis, herbs, tobacco, and underbrush. One of the most concentrated wines of the vintage, it is a huge, full-bodied, weighty, rich wine whose tannins are getting silkier and silkier. It appears set for another 30-40 years of life. Anticipated maturity: now-2050. (RP 98)

Château Margaux Set of 3

Château Margaux 3 bottles 750ml each. The color is opaque ruby/purple. The nose offers aromas of licorice and sweet smoky new oak intermixed with jammy black fruits, licorice, and minerals. The wine is medium to full-bodied, with extraordinary richness, fabulous equilibrium, and hefty tannin in the finish. This is a thrilling Margaux that will always be softer and more evolved than its broader-shouldered 1996. Anticipated maturity: now-2040.

Super Tuscan Set of 3

Tignanello Sangiovese 2011. "A powerful red, with plum, blackberry and black cherry flavors that border on jammy, all kept in check by juicy acidity and firm, dense tannins and leather and earth accents. Finishes long, with a mineral flourish. Best from 2015 through 2023." 92 Points. International Wine Cellar.

Guado al Tasso 2011. "Rich yet tightly wound, delivering cherry, black currant, floral, spice and mineral flavors. The structure keeps this compact and monolithic for now, with a resonant finish that should develop beautifully over the next decade or so." 93 Points. Wine Spectator.

Cepparello Sangiovese 2008. "Deep ruby. Cola-like notes complicate aromas of black cherry, rhubarb and cocoa. Ripe, smooth and dense, with velvety, seamless flavors of black cherry, plum and spicy oak. Finishes spicy, vibrant and long. This is very impressive but shows less sangiovese perfume than usual. Anticipated maturity: 2019-2034." 92 Points. Wine Spectator.

International Cabernet Set of 3

Catena Zapata Nicolas 2009. "A concentrated yet lively red, with embedded acidity backing rich cassis, racy black cherry puree and mocha notes. This is detailed, delivering a long finish of spice cake, tarry mineral and fruit. Delicious now, but will reward patience. Best from 2014 through 2019. 1,500 cases imported." 94 Points. Wine Spectator.

Château Lascombes 2009. "Bright red-ruby. Sexy aromas of coffee, nuts and cherry oak. Supple, sweet and chocolaty. Nicely concentrated, broad and round, showing a lush texture and a good chewy texture. Finishes with sweet tannins and a lingering element of smoky oak. Lovely claret." 92 Points. International Wine Cellar.

Continuum 2010. "An enticing, graceful style, this achieves a deft balance and refined dark berry, cedar and black licorice notes that linger on the finish as the tannins gain traction and grip." 93 Points. Wine Spectator.

Chateauneuf-du-Pape Set of 3

Château de Beaucastel Chateauneuf-du-Pape 2010. "Very sleek and refined despite the obvious heft, featuring steeped red and black currant fruit studded with bergamot, blood orange, sweet tobacco and alder notes. The long, racy finish has a lovely echo of singed mesquite." 94 Points. Wine Spectator.

La Ferme du Mont "Côtes Capelan" Chateauneuf-du-Pape 2010. "The prodigious 2010 boasts abundant notes of acacia flowers interwoven with blackberries, black raspberries, licorice, incense and a touch of graphite. The wine hits the palate with tremendous authority, impressive purity and a full-bodied, layered finish. Drink it over the next two decades." 98 Points. The Wine Advocate.

Châteauneuf-du-Pape Rouge, La Crau, Domaine du Vieux Télégraphe 2011. "Pepper garrigue and briar notes wrapped around a core of steeped cherry, damson plum and blackberry fruit. Cedar and sandalwood accents line the finish, revealing a hint of blood orange. This needs some cellaring to unwind fully." 93 Points Wine Spectator.

International Chardonnay Set of 2

Ramey Hyde Vineyard 2010. "Light gold. Intense, mineral inflected aromas of pear, nectarine and white flowers. Bright, penetrating and emphatically dry, offering vibrant citrus and orchard fruit flavors and showing pronounced minerality. The strikingly long, energetic finish features notes of iodine, smoke and candied ginger, with a sneaky note of pit fruits adding depth." 94 Points. International Wine Cellar.

Domaine Comtesse Bernard de Cherisey Meursault Blagny 1er Cru "La Genelotte" 2008. "Essence of lime blossom in aroma and flavor is complemented by honeysuckle and ripe apple notes, with a hint of hazelnut. Ample flesh gives an impression of roundness, with the bright acidity refreshing the finish. Best from 2012 through 2022." 90 points. Wine Spectator.

Sauvignon Blanc Tasting Set of 2

Pascal Cotat: Les Monts Damnes 2012. The explosive aromatics of Cotat's Sancerre Les Monts Damnes display slate, honey, almonds, flowers, and grass. A dense, juicy, concentrated, broad-shouldered wine, its medium to full-bodied personality is redolent with salty minerals, candied lemons, white peaches, slate, and hazelnuts. This effort's lengthy finish must be experienced to be believed. Drink it over the next 15 years.

Merry Edwards Sauvignon Blanc 2012. "Smooth and silky, with spicy details of nutmeg and quince joined by pure, ripe honeydew melon and cantaloupe flavors. Pear, lemon zest and apricot notes are elegant, lithe, and wonderfully juicy on the finish." 92 Points. Wine Spectator.

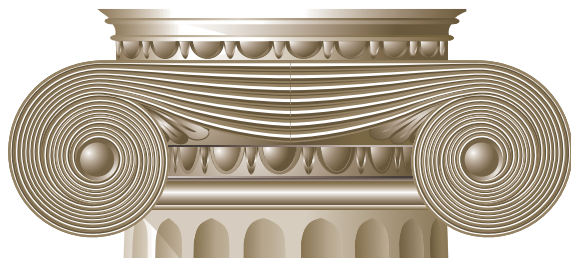
